## HAVING YOUR SAY - ADDING AGENDA ITEMS

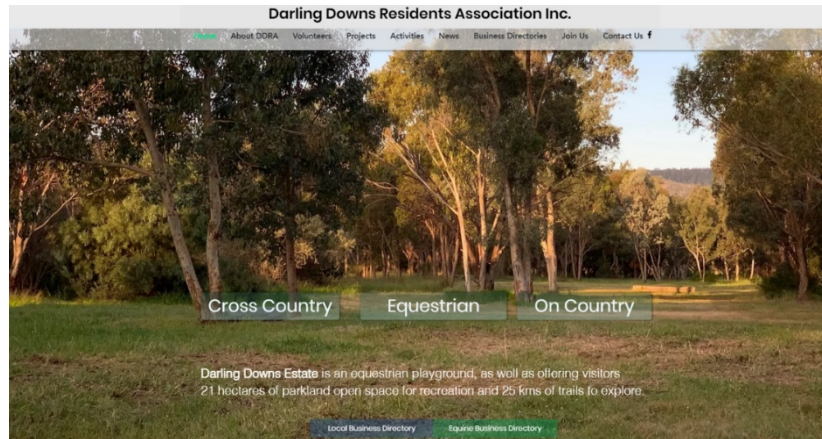
